Fostering Success Act


- Georgia legislatures passed House Bill 424 in 2022
- Tax credit for contributions to a qualified Foster Child Support
 Organization that can be used towards education, mentoring, and
 wraparound services for young adults transitioning out of foster care
- Provides up to \$20 million in state tax credits to offset donations to certified agencies
- Georgia taxpayers can redirect their taxes to Wellroot


