

## **NACBH Event Safety Protocol Reminders**

NACBH looks forward to providing a successful and safe event with the health and well-being of our attendees, volunteers and staff being our top priority. Please review the following safety protocols carefully and be mindful of others while engaging in NACBH activities or enjoying the host hotel.

## Safety Protocols and Expectations:

- Vaccination: All attendees are expected to be vaccinated (absent an exemption).
- Masks: All attendees are strongly encouraged to wear masks in group settings regardless of vaccination status. For the protection of you and others, attendees who have an exemption to vaccination must wear a mask while participating in all conference activities or when present in conference areas.
- Symptom Checks: We ask that all attendees and staff come symptom-free of illness and refrain from attending functions should they begin feeling under the weather, or exhibit any symptoms related to COVID-19.
- Social distancing: NACBH will disperse seating in a manner that allows attendees to spread out while in sessions and/or participating in event activities. Please be mindful of others and do not approach for handshakes or hugs unless you first inquire about the comfort level of those you are greeting.
- Meals: Breakfasts will consist of buffet service offered by an attendant, along with an assortment of individually wrapped items. Break items will also be individually wrapped.
- Sanitizer stations: Attendees and staff should use hand sanitizer frequently to protect yourself and others around you. Hand sanitizer will be readily available throughout the host hotel.
- Clean Environment: High-touched surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected frequently for your safety.
- Information Sharing: Should a participant receive a positive COVID-19 diagnosis during, or within 14
  days after attending the event, participants are obligated to report the positive diagnosis and inform
  the NACBH Team for necessary follow-up with fellow attendees.

Please note: NACBH Emerging Best Practices attendees are expected to be vaccinated, however, NACBH will not be requiring proof of vaccination records on site.
