3 D's


- Disease

- Disability






Whatever it Takes... Harlem Children's Zone in Salem, Oregon?







Parental Stress, QIC-EC study 2012

Comparison Neighborhoods








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Parenting Stress Index Overall

- Working directly with families lowers the Toxic Stress level
- The Neighbor Connectors were working with families to build community resilience
- The next question is whether we can improve Social Determinants of Health by applying the same approach
- Neighbor Connectors became Certified Community Health Workers






